

# **Club Championships 2011-12**

**Dates** As on the Club's Event Calendar

**Eligibility** All current financial members who also hold a current New Zealand kart sport licence. Membership payment will be accepted on the day.

**Classes are as follows:-**

Cadets  
Junior Restricted  
Junior Yamaha  
Junior Clubsport 120  
100cc Yamaha Lights  
100cc Yamaha Heavies  
Rotax Max Lights  
Rotax Max Heavies  
Senior Clubsport 120  
Open Class

1. One set of wets and one set of dry tyres per day as per NZKS rules.
2. Teching may be carried out at any meeting.
3. Non-rated and or non-eligible drivers will run off rear of field.
4. Normal club day time table will apply.
5. Normal entry fees also apply.
6. The award of trophies will be decided prior to last round. Classes of less than 3 entries may be accepted but awards will be at the discretion of the organising committee.
7. Drivers are able to run in any class throughout the rounds and can win events in more than one class.

**POINTS FORMATS:**

A positive points system will be used, i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> 16 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 15 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 14 points, through to 16<sup>th</sup> 1 point.

DQ = last place - 5 points. Did not start = last place – 1 point.

**All heats count until after the last round when worst heat of the entire series is dropped.**

Ties will be determined by KartSport NZ Rule P5.

Points are determined as shown below:

- A. All competitors who enter rounds 1, 2 & 3 earn 50 bonus points per round.  
All competitors who enter Round 4 earn double bonus points (i.e. 100 bonus points).  
Any competitor who does not enter or race in any round will be awarded 0 points for that round.

A competitor must enter and have one practice or race to qualify for that round's 50 bonus points.

- B. A competitor who is disqualified from a heat will receive last place -5 points. When a competitor is disqualified for the day they will only carry their bonus points from that round through the series.
- C. To achieve an overall result all points from the 4 rounds will be added. Then the worst 2 heats over the series will then be dropped to determine place getter over the series. In the case of a tie the competitors will be declared equal.
- D. Any Junior competitor who must move up a class during the Series may take all of his/her bonus points, plus 50% of any other points awarded forward to the new class. This only applies to Junior competitors who are forced to move up due to age restrictions.
- E. If a Junior competitor moves up for the Final Round they will run at the rear of the field.
